15 AMENDMENT TO GSO FUNDING POLICY

19 GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION,  
20

21 WHEREAS the Graduate and Professional Student Association of Arizona State  
22 University must operate under a thoughtfully developed ASASU Constitution and GPSA  
23 Bylaws which promote effectiveness, efficiency, and accountability, and  
24

25 NOTING that the Assembly Operations Committee needs to require only seven rather  
26 than ten calendar days lead time to hear graduate student organization (GSO) funding  
27 requests, and  
28

29 FURTHER NOTING that concern has been expressed that too little attention is paid to  
30 following-up on funded organizations and events to ensure that GPSA's funding goals are  
31 being served by its investment in student organizations, and  
32

33 FURTHER NOTING that certain Assembly Members and Assembly Operations  
34 Committee members have advocated a post-event funding report to be submitted by the  
35 student organization when submitting its itemized receipts for disbursement, and  
36

37 FURTHER NOTING that withholding of disbursements until this form is submitted  
38 should adequately align incentives for organizations to submit such information without  
39 unduly burdening the student organization or GPSA administration,  
40

41 BE IT ENACTED THAT upon passage of this bill all funded graduate student  
42 organizations will be required to submit a post-event funding report along with other  
43 required documents prior to receiving any disbursement of GPSA funds, and

45 FURTHER LET THE GPSA Bylaws be amended as follows:

47 AMEND Lines 492-494, Title V, Article 1, Section D, Subsection a:

- a. All funding requests are to be completed and submitted to the GPSA office ten (10) calendar days prior to the next Assembly meeting. Incomplete requests will not be considered.

- a. All funding requests are to be completed and submitted to the GPSA office seven (7) calendar days prior to the next Assembly meeting. Incomplete requests will not be considered.

- a. A post-event funding report form must be submitted along with all itemized receipts in order to be eligible for any disbursement.
