19 GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION,

21 WHEREAS the Graduate and Professional Students Association Assembly seeks to be  
22 versatile and swift in its reaction to the requests which its representatives make of the  
23 organization, and to have sufficient foresight to anticipate upcoming affairs that will  
24 affect the academic and social well-being of all graduate students,

26 BE IT ENACTED that the GPSA will hereafter maintain a standing committee which  
27 shall be called the "Special Initiatives Committee"

29 LET the GPSA Bylaws reflect the motion:

31 1) INSERT at Title V

33 Article 7. Special Initiatives Committee

34 A. The Special Initiatives Committee is charged with maintaining

35 situational awareness of the academic and social needs of graduate

36 and professional students, and when the need arises from the

37 community of graduate students to act on an issue, the members of

38 the Committee will act to address this need directly or otherwise.

- 39                   B. The Special Initiatives Committee shall organize the annual  
40                   Graduate and Professional Student Appreciation Week and Picnic  
41                   in conjunction with the Graduate College.
- 42                   C. The Special Initiatives Committee may not pass legislation or  
43                   distribute funds.
- 44                   D. The Assembly President will appoint no fewer than four (4)  
45                   Assembly members to serve on the Special Initiatives Committee.
