14 BILL IN OPPOSITION TO ARIZONA HB 2181

16 GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION,

18 WHEREAS the Graduate and Professional Student Association of Arizona State  
19 University exists to represent and protect the interests of graduate students,  
20

21 NOTING THAT HB 2181 is a current Arizona House of Representatives bill that would  
22 replace the current university funding system with a voucher system,  
23

24 FURTHER NOTING THAT in the 2011-2012 GPSA Policy Directive and in past  
25 Assembly legislation (AB 45, March 2011), GPSA has formally opposed a voucher  
26 funding system,

28 BE IT RESOLVED THAT the GPSA formally oppose HB 2181 and enact this  
29 opposition by encouraging student advocacy against it, through direct GPSA advocacy to  
30 ASA and the Arizona State Legislature, and through a press release from the GPSA to the  
31 various ASU and Valley newspapers stating its opposition to this measure.
