17 RESOLUTION ON PRESENTATION OF REFERENDA

20 GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION,
21

22 WHEREAS the Graduate and Professional Student Association of Arizona State
23 University must operate under a thoughtfully developed ASASU Constitution and GPSA
24 Bylaws which promote effectiveness, efficiency, and accountability, and
25

26 NOTING that already seven referenda to amend the ASASU Constitution have been
27 proposed and passed by the GPSA Assembly (Assembly Bills 41, 42, 43, 44, 52, and 53
28 from the Seventh Legislative Session and Assembly Bill 03 from the Eighth Legislative
29 Session) and stand ready for vote by all GPSA members during this 2010-2011 fall
30 semester, and

32 FURTHER NOTING that all seven referenda were proposed and sponsored by the same
33 individual who desires that the amendments be proposed to students in as clear and
34 concise a matter as possible, and

36 FURTHER NOTING that since the GPSA section (Title III) of the ASASU Constitution
37 is only five pages in total length,
38

39 BE IT ENACTED THAT upon passage of this bill all seven referenda will be combined
40 into one omnibus proposal to revise Title III of the ASASU Constitution according to the
41 amendment referenda authorized by the GPSA Assembly through passage of the
42 Assembly Bills described herein. Copies of the proposed Title III (markup and non-
43 markup versions) are available in the Documents and Resources section of the GPSA

46 THE GPSA ASSEMBLY HEREBY DIRECTS the ASASU Elections Director to place the
47 following referendum item on the ballot during a Fall special election no later than September 30,

56 The ASU Graduate & Professional Student Association (GPSA) has passed several resolutions to
57 amend its section (Title III) of the Associated Students of Arizona State University (ASASU)
58 Constitution. Initial revisions were made as part of the GPSA’s annual review of its governing
59 documents and approved as Assembly Bill 41, with subsequent changes presented to and
60 authorized by the GPSA Assembly through passage of Assembly Bills 42, 43, 44, 52, and 53
61 from the Seventh Legislative Session (2009-2010) and Assembly Bills 03 and 05 from
62 the Eighth Legislative Session (2010-2011). The original version of Title III of the ASASU
