27 Week are to be moved from the office of Internal Affairs to the office of Professional
28 Development, and communications duties from the office of Internal Affairs to the
29 Directors in the President's office, and maintenance of the Assembly manual from
30 Internal Affairs to the Assembly Operations committee, with whom that responsibility
31 already resides, and

34 intended revision to the duties of its Officers,
