15 A BILL TO IMPLEMENT THE DIRECT ELECTION OF GPSA JUDICIARY
16 COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS

19 GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION,

21 TO ENCOURAGE the participation of the full membership of the GPSA in the student
22 government and,
23

24 TO INCREASE students' voice in the affairs of the GPSA,
25

26 BE IT RESOLVED THAT the process by which GPSA Judiciary Committee members
27 are appointed will originate in the GPSA, and
28

29 BE IT ENACTED that the GPSA Bylaws should be modified to reflect this resolution as
30 follows:

32 AMEND Title VI, Article 7, Section C to read:
33

34 C. The Judiciary shall consist of three Justices, each appointed to serve a term
35 no longer than two years and which end in May. Nominations will be solicited
36 during the annual spring elections to fill the seats of any outgoing Justices.
37 The GPSA President will call for and consider applicants to fill any interim
38 vacancies for the remainder of that academic year. The interim nominee must
39 then be approved by two-thirds (2/3) of Assembly Members present and
40 voting. All GPSA members in good academic standing are eligible to serve as
41 Justices. There is no limit on the number of terms a Justice may serve.
