14 REVISION OF DUTIES TO INCLUDE A POLICY DIRECTIVE

17 GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION,

20 BE IT ENACTED that the GPSA Assembly and Executives will annually produce and publicly present a
21 policy directive that outlines important contemporary issues that the GPSA seeks to address via legislative
22 and organizational actions. To enact such change:
23

24 AMEND the GPSA Bylaws as follows:
25

- 26 1) INSERT at Title I, Article 2, Section A, subsection r
27 r. To produce the GPSA Annual Policy Directive jointly with the GPSA Assembly
28 President, the Executive Committee, and affiliated GPSA Assembly members.

- 30 2) INSERT at Title I, Article 2, Section B, subsection l
31 l. To produce the GPSA Annual Policy Directive jointly with the GPSA President, the
32 Executive Committee, Assembly President and affiliated GPSA Assembly members.

- 34 3) INSERT at Title I, Article 2, Section C, subsection p
35 p. To produce the GPSA Annual Policy Directive jointly with the GPSA President, the
36 Executive Committee, Assembly President and affiliated GPSA Assembly members.

- 38 4) INSERT at Title I, Article 2, Section D, subsection k.
39 k. To produce the GPSA Annual Policy Directive jointly with the GPSA President, the
40 Executive Committee, Assembly President and affiliated GPSA Assembly members.

- 42 5) INSERT at Title II, Article 1, Section J, subsection m
43 m. To produce the GPSA Annual Policy Directive jointly with the GPSA President, the
44 Executive Committee, and affiliated GPSA Assembly members. The Assembly President
45 will present a bill to approve the Policy Directive in the first Assembly session of fall
46 semester.

- 48 6) INSERT at Title VI, Article 8:
49 GPSA Annual Policy Directive. The document will be composed annually and will
50 outline important contemporary issues that the GPSA Executive Committee and
51 Assembly seek to address via legislative and organizational actions in the upcoming year.
52 The President will produce a draft of the Directive with the GPSA Assembly President
53 and the Executive Committee during the summer with input from Assembly members
54 from the Spring Special Session. When the Directive is finalized, the President will
55 submit the document to the Assembly, via the Assembly President, for debate and vote,
56 where it must be adopted by a majority of seated Assembly members. The Assembly
57 President will present a bill to approve the Policy Directive in the first Assembly session
58 of fall semester.
