15 AN ACT Allowing Attendance at the March 16, 2012 GPSA Assembly Meeting to Meet
16 the Requirements of Candidacy for the 2012-13 GPSA Elections

19 THE GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION,

21 WHEREAS Title III, Article 1, Section D, Subsection e requires that those seeking office
22 in GPSA to attend a full Assembly meeting prior to submitting any official elections
23 paperwork;

24 BELIEVING this provision to be a constitutional aspect of previous GPSA elections:

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26 The public and potential candidates should receive notice of this provision in published
27 elections information, and said information should be accessible year round on the GPSA
28 website.

- 30 A. Noting that this provision is published on the GPSA website and has been for at
31 least the last three years.
 - 32 B. In addition to other published elections information, GPSA leaders independent of
33 the ASASU Elections Director sent an elections notice to all members of the
34 GradStu ListServ on February 16, 2012.
 - 35 C. A regularly scheduled Assembly meeting convened on Friday, February 17th, 2012
36 and each month prior during the 2011-12 academic year.

37 BELIEVING that the timing of information regarding this provision did not reflect
38 previous election schedules and therefore some otherwise, qualified candidates may not
39 have read the provision prior to the February GPSA Assembly meeting:

- 40 A. There are eighteen students who submitted timely candidate applications, so noted
41 in the below list provided by the ASASU Elections Director.

42 B. Elections materials are usually sent out earlier than mid-February, which would
 43 normally give candidates an earlier notice of the provision to attend an Assembly
 44 meeting.

45 NOTING that this provision’s intention is good, but acknowledging some may not have
 46 been aware of the provision;

 48 THEREFORE ESTABLISHES the March 16, 2012 GPSA Assembly meeting as the final
 49 opportunity to meet the requirements contained in Title III, Article 1, Dection D,
 50 Subsection e of the Bylaws for 2012-2013 GPSA elections;

 52 DIRECTS the Elections Director to immediately reinstate the candidacy of any candidate
 53 on the below list who was denied the opportunity to run for office because of Title III,
 54 Article 1, Section D, if they otherwise would be eligible to run; and if they attended the
 55 March 16, 2012 GPSA Assembly meeting; and to promptly notify them as such.
